Car Parking

Cabinet were advised of the proposals for the introduction of free car parking across key Tees Valley Town Centres to make it easier, cheaper and more convenient for people to use Tees Valley high streets and support local businesses.

The proposed scope of the policy proposal is to introduce a minimum of two hours up to a maximum of three hours' free car parking for two years in each of the five Tees Valley Local Authority primary town centres, namely; Darlington, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar and Stockton.

- Approved the proposed introduction of free car parking across the car park areas designated at **Appendices 1-5** for two years as part of the wider Indigenous Growth Programme (IGP); and
