	The impact of Covid 19 has been significant on training providers ability to deliver training and Tees Valley residents to access it. The performance of providers has been less than anticipated. To ensure effective use of public spending reconciliation is considered necessary.
	Mayor Houchen acknowledged the large amount of work undertaken by TVCA and local authority counterparts to allocate funds from September 2022.
	A member asked for confirmation that discussions had taken place with Darlington College. Mayor Houchen and the Director of Business and Skills confirmed that extensive discussions had taken place with all learning providers.
	RESOLVED that Cabinet:
	i. Approved the application of a 90% reconciliation threshold to all TVCA Adult Education Budget funded providers for the 2020/21 academic year against their core allocations.
	ii. Agreed to base the decisions on the (R14) end of year performance data that has now been received by TVCA and will be analysed during December;
