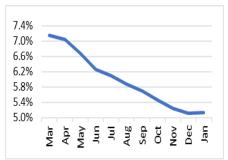

In the ten months since March 2021, the number of Tees Valley payrolled employees has increased by 11,797



Over the same period, those on **Universal Credit Searching for** Work has fallen from 7.1% to 5.1%.

Business and Consumer Confidence



North East businesses with 'high' confidence in January remained steady at 76.1%. This figure remains well above the UK level of 71.5%.



45.7% of North East businesses in January have a workforce which have returned to the workplace; compared to 41.0% in the previous month. The increase can be attributed to the relaxation of COVID-19

restrictions following Plan 'B' measures.



February's UK GfK Consumer Confidence Index fell by seven points to -26, due to fears of higher prices and increasing interest rates. This is the lowest headline score observed for 13 months, when the index was at -28 in January 2021 and is down from recent highs of -7 in July 2021.

Movement of People



Regionally Road/Traffic usage has fallen 16.2% month on month in February. This decrease can be tied to the shorter month of February, a slow return to the office for some workers and potentially the poor weather during February.



Teesside Airport passenger numbers in January (2,882) were down 50.3% on that for December 2021. The fall in passenger numbers during January can be linked to high COVID numbers at home and abroad as well as seasonal variations due to less flights during the winter months.

Cargo ship and tankers visiting Tees and Hartlepool ports decreased by 24.9% in February month on month. There has also been a decrease nationally, potentially due to the increasing fuel costs, supply chain issues and freight costs remaining relatively high.

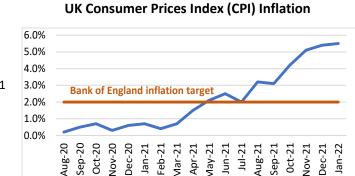


Google Mobility Data shows that retail and recreation footfall is down around 7% from pre-pandemic levels. This is likely due to the rise in the cost of living resulting in alongside an increase in online shopping. Additionally, parks footfall is down 8% likely due inclement weather throughout February.

UK GDP increased 1.0% in 2021 Q4



- The Bank of England aims to keep CPI inflation within 1% either side of its 2% target.
- UK Inflation climbed to 5.5% in January, up from 5.4% in December and up from 0.7% in January 2021.
- The continued high level of inflation is primarily due to large upward contributions from housing and household services (i.e., energy costs) as well as transport (i.e., motor fuels and second-hand cars).
