





Tees Valley – Plan for Additional Resurfacing and other Highways Maintenance Work (2023/24 and 2024/25)

Made possible by reallocated HS2 funding

Tees Valley Combined Authority received £2,096,800 for highways maintenance for 2023/24 from the UK Government in the 2023 Budget.

A further £1,499,000 for 2023/24, and the same amount for 2024/25, for local road resurfacing and wider maintenance activity was announced on 4 October 2023 as part of additional highways maintenance funding.

The funding has been allocated to the five Tees Valley Local Highway Authorities.

The following is the resurfacing and other highway maintenance activity, which is planned, or has already been delivered, with the 2023/24 and 2024/25 funding.

Work Completed in 2023/24 or Scheduled in 2024/25

Using the funding outlined in the above, the five Tees Valley Local Authorities have completed, or have scheduled, work including but not limited to:

- Carriageway Reconstruction
- Carriageway Resurfacing
- Footway Repair Works
- Verge Works
- Drainage Schemes; and
- Patching Works.

In terms of cost, some of the largest schemes planned for 2024-25 include:

- Carriageway reconstruction on Roundhill Road, Darlington;
- Carriageway resurfacing on A689 Newton Bewley to Claxton eastbound in Hartlepool;
- Phase 1 carriageway resurfacing on The Grove, Marton, in Middlesbrough;
- Full carriageway resurfacing with partial reconstruction on the A171 from Guisborough to Charltons in Redcar & Cleveland; and
- Carriageway resurfacing on Durham Road in Stockton-On-Tees.

The Five Tees Valley Local Highway Authorities are introducing Innovation in the delivery of highways maintenance in the following ways:

Middlesbrough Council	Carriageway Resurfacing: laid 64,002m2 of asphalt in 2023-24, of which 89.7% is warm-mix stone mastic asphalt with polymer modified binders which help to exceed the expected design life of the road surface, requiring less maintenance over the longer term. They enhance durability, improve flexibility, improve resistance to water damage, provide better skid resistance, and stability under heavy traffic.
Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council	Changed the weighting on highway maintenance contracts to give more weighting to quality and less to price.
20.04gii 00diioli	The Carbon Reduction & Innovation question has been increased to a 40% weighting, putting more emphasis on reducing carbon emissions, in line with the Council's vision of being carbon neutral by 2030.

How the Tees Valley Local Authorities ensure that resurfacing works are not undermined by repeated digging up of the same road by utility companies.

Darlington Borough Council utilise Section 58 protection, which prohibits utilities from excavating in the same area for 2 years following resurfacing (3 years following reconstruction). Meetings are held quarterly with utility companies to aid the co-ordination of works and ensure they are informed of all upcoming schemes. S58 protection is submitted via Street Manager in advance to make utility companies aware of Council works. Site meetings are held to look at alternative routes, to avoid protected areas and see if there can be any shared work locations to reduce time on site. Inspections are carried out on all works, and any failures go through a defect process which ensure the defects are remedied.







Hartlepool Borough Council shares all resurfacing programmes once available with respective undertakers to request any programmed / non-essential works are planned in prior to resurfacing work taking place and inform that any non-emergency work will not be permitted during the protected Section 58 period once resurfacing has taken place. Hartlepool attends quarterly coordination meetings with undertakers and neighbouring LAs.

Middlesbrough Council send out carriageway resurfacing programmes and footpath programmes to all neighbouring councils and utility providers to ensure that they have foresight of what works are planned to be undertaken within the coming year. This list is distributed to request that any programmed or non-essential work is planned prior to any resurfacing work taking place and to notify the utility providers that any non-emergency work will not be granted during the Section 58 protected period, once Middlesbrough Council's resurfacing or footpath works have been carried out.

Redcar & Cleveland Borough Council submit a proposed section 58 notice in advance of the date on which works are expected to finish, providing utility companies or private contractors/developers an opportunity to conduct their works in advance of the restriction coming into force. This process promotes better works planning and co-ordination, helps minimise disruption to road users, and helps to prolong the life of the roads. The Council also encourages collaborative working, which helps to minimise the impact on highway users through reduced disruption and occupation of the highway.

Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council currently runs a permitting scheme which allows for coordination and road space sharing. As part of this, quarterly co-ordination meetings are attended by all parties where forward programmes are shared, and conflicts identified early and managed accordingly.
