# SUPER CORONATION FACTS

1 A Coronation is a special ceremony where a person is officially made King or Queen of a country. It's like a big party where everyone in the country comes together to celebrate the new King or Queen.



2 King Charles III and Camilla, Queen Consort will become the new monarchs of the United Kingdom and the additional 14 Commonwealth Realms.



5 King Charles III has a tree frog named after him, in honour of his efforts to protect the world's rainforests.



8 When certain people visit the U.S. they are given code names of their own. King Charles III's code name is 'Unicorn' which is the national animal of Scotland.



3 At the age of 74, King Charles III is the oldest person in British history to be named monarch.



6 The King plays three instruments – piano, cello, and trumpet.



9 The Coronation will take place at Westminster Abbey in London, which is a very old and beautiful church where 39 Kings and Queens have been crowned before.



4 Our new King wrote a children's book, The Old Man of Lochnagar, based on stories he would tell his younger brother and sister, which has now been turned into a short film.



7 The King also paints, writes, is a pilot, and played many sports in his life – a man of many talents!



10 It will be a very colourful and musical event, with many flags, flowers, banners, trumpets, drums, choirs, orchestras, and singers performing.

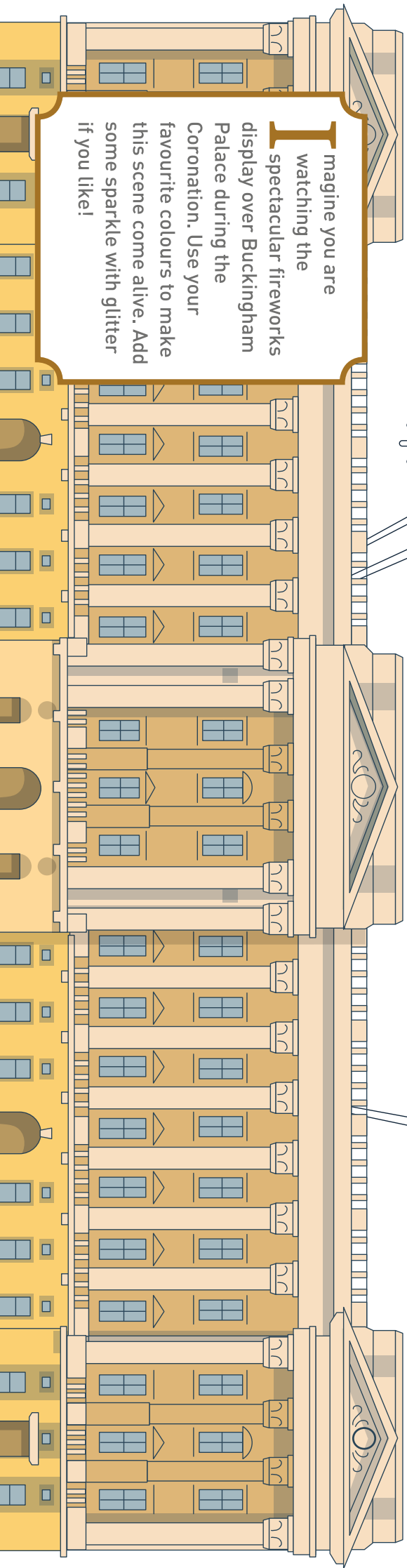




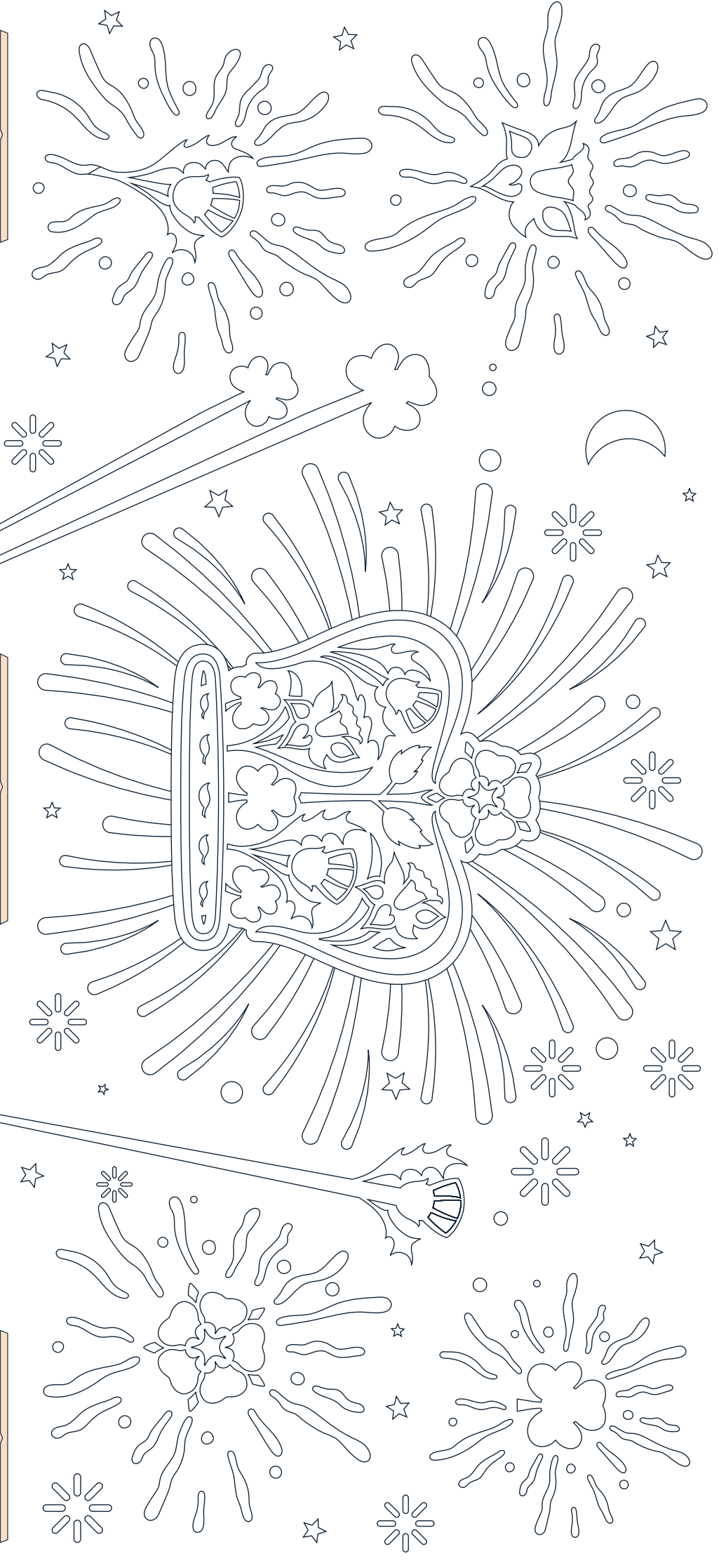
# WESTMINSTER MAZE

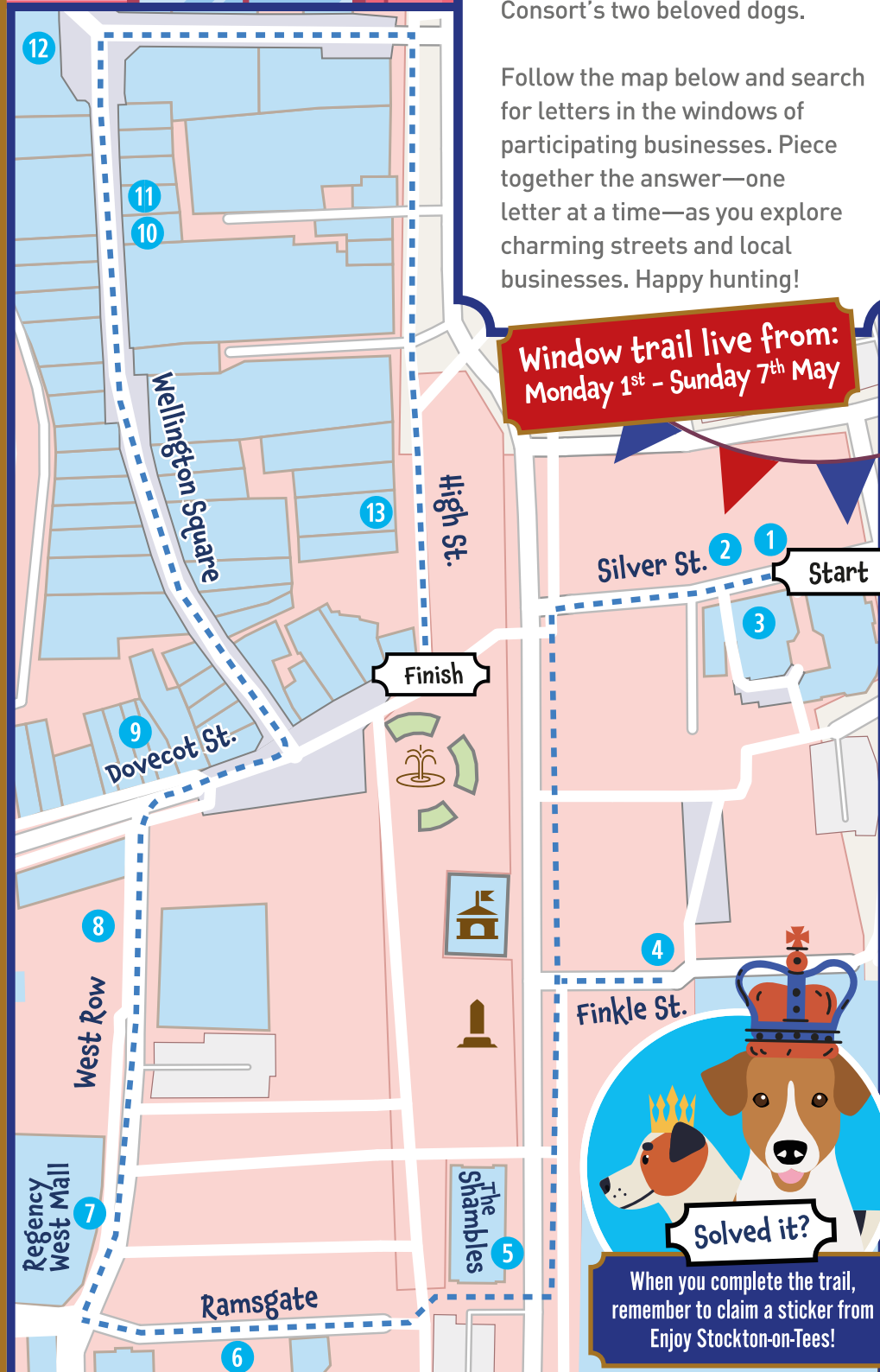

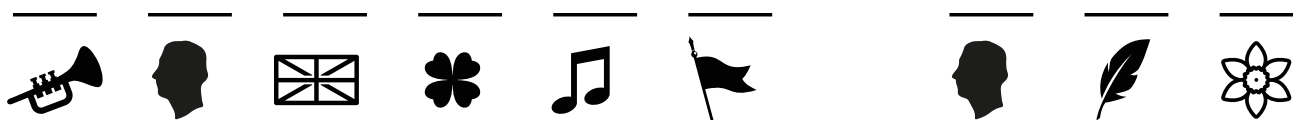
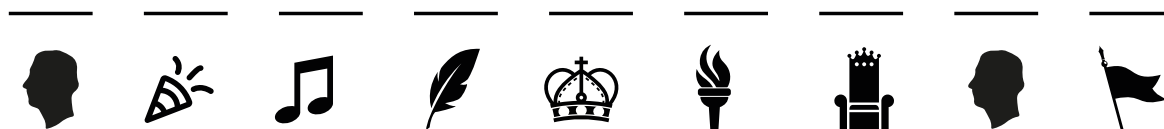
