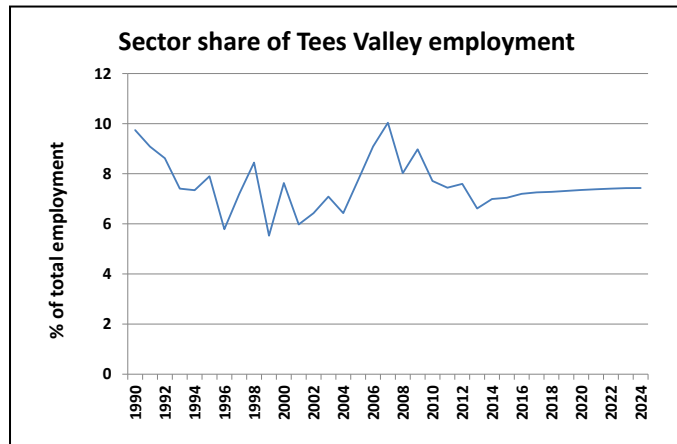

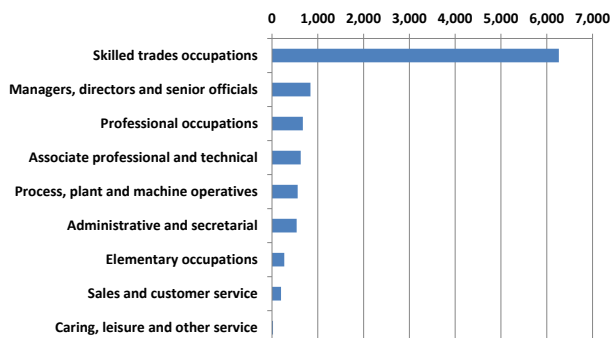

### Total occupation requirement, 2014-2024

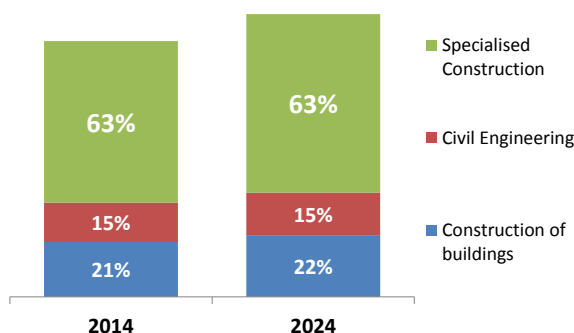


### Employment by gender and status
