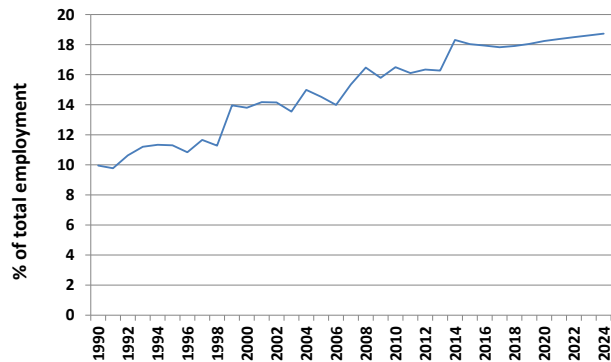

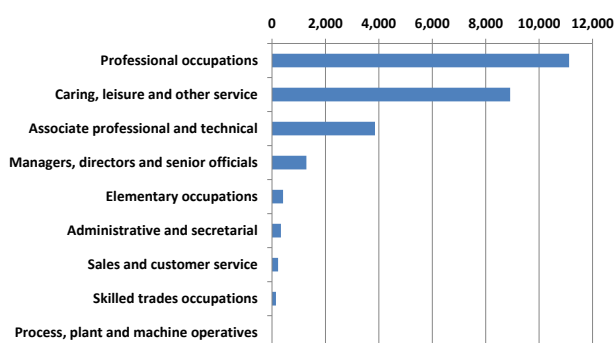

Total occupation requirement, 2014-2024

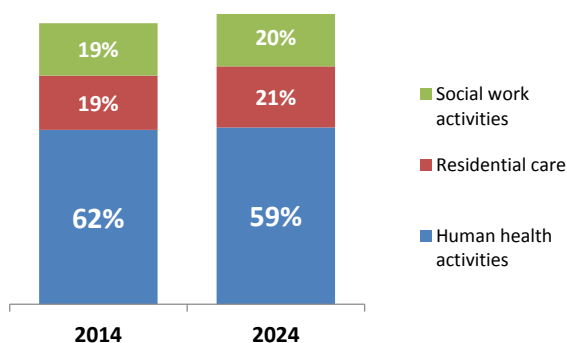


Employment by gender and status
