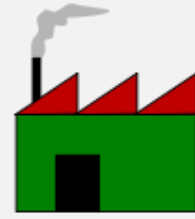


# Tees Valley Sector Profile

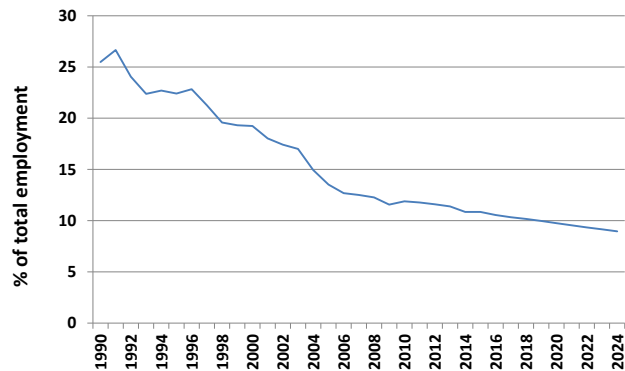

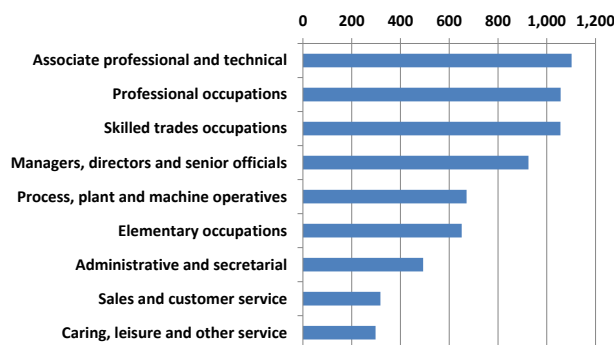

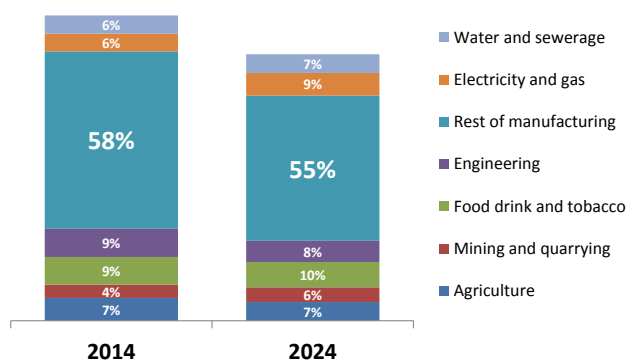
