Opportunity	Introduce a new shared-use path near Freemans Roundabout that everyone can use, improved crossing will also connect with the existing walking, wheeling, and cycling paths, creating a continuous route.
Benefit	 Safer crossing point and more attractive journeys for people walking, wheeling, and cycling.
Impact	We may need to cut the vegetation on East Street. Where possible we will look to replant any vegetation or greenery.
